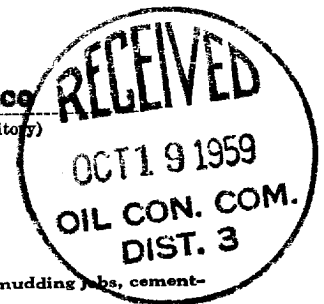

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Set open hole bridge plug at 2940' R.D.F.
2. Ran 92 fts. 5 1/2", 15.50, J-55 csg. on Sept. 15, 1959. Set stage collar @ 2161.46' R.D.F. Csg. landed @ 2927.46' R.D.F. Cmt. 1st stage w/65 sz reg. cut. w/2 1/2 gcl.
3. Ran temperature survey on 1st stage cmt. Cmt. top at 2500'.
4. Cmt. 2nd stage w/50 sz reg. w/2 1/2 gcl on September 16, 1959.
5. Ran temp survey on 2nd stage Cement top at 1875'.
6. Drill bridge plug and clean out to T.D. (3076' R.D.F.) Natural completion.
7. Ran 96 fts. 2-3/8", 14.77, J-55 tubing on September 18, 1959. Tubing landed at 2963' R.D.F.
