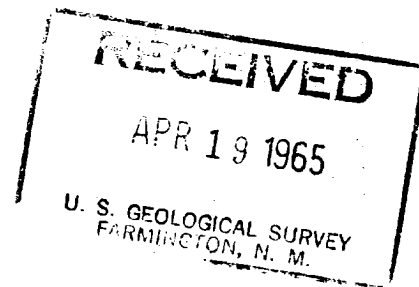

A 6 3/4" hole will be drilled to approximately 30' and one joint 5 1/2" 14# csg. run and cemented to surface. A 4 3/4" hole will then be drilled using air as the circulating medium to a depth sufficient to test the Sanostee Sand.

Instructions

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

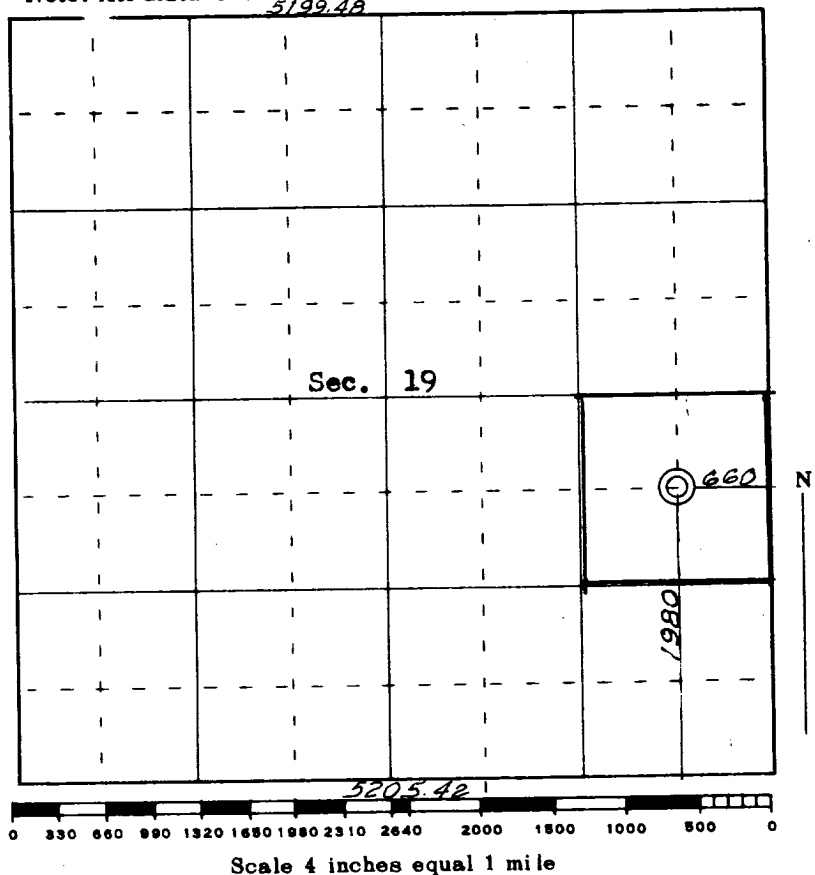
