

Breakdown Pressure 100 lbs., Treating Pressure 900 lbs., Final - Vacuum, Injection Rate 44.1 bpm. Scrubbed an average of 22 BOPF. Run 2797' of 2 3/8" tubing landed at 2795'. Installed rods and pump. Oil to tank 9:15 p.m. 6-14-58.
