

**THE APPLICATION OF AZTEC OIL &  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.**

**ORDER NO. MC-1663**

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 2, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Richardson Well No. 5 located in Unit G of Section 21, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 8th day of October, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Richardson Well No. 5 located in Unit G of Section 21, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Artco Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 2, 1962, for permission to daily complete its Richardson Well No. 2 located in Unit 6 of Section 21, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, WPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of October, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Artco Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to daily complete its Richardson Well No. 2 located in Unit 6 of Section 21, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, WPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
