DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 8/7/63. Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 210'. Set 9-5/8" casing at 210' KB, cemented with 100 sx of regular with 2% CaCl₂. Plug down at 3:30 A.M., 8/8/63. Cement circulated. Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 6805'. Set 5-1/2" casing at 6814', stage collar set at 4858', cemented through casing shoe with 115 sx Diamix and 111 sx of regular. Bumped plug at 3:00 P.M., 8/29/63 with 2000 psi - held okay. Cemented MV through stage collar with 54 sx of regular and 37 sx Diamix "A". Lost circulation when cement hit formation, but regained circulation after 90 bbls. displacement. Bumped plug at 6:30 P.M., 8/29/63 with 2000 psi - held okay.
