

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 28, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Williams Well No. 1-24 located in Unit H of Section 24, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of November, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Williams Well No. 1-24 located in Unit H of Section 24, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

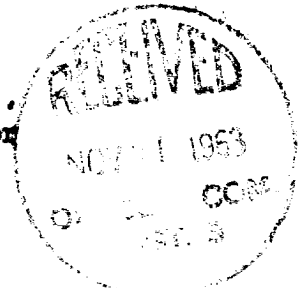
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS
OF THE COMMISSION

There are provisions of this Act, contained in the
Act, which relate to the regulation of the
Commission on October 28, 1923, for the purpose of giving complete
to William Wolf No. 1-14 located in Unit H of Section 24, Township
31 North, Range 13 West, T8N, R13W, S24, New Mexico, and
the same shall be the same as the provisions of the
and the Basin-Excess Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of November, 1923, the Secretary
has signed.

- (1) That the Commission has been duly organized under the
provisions of this Act, and the Commission, its rules and regulations;
- (2) That the Commission has been duly organized and provided
that all operations of the Commission have been duly notified, and
- (3) That no objection has been made to the Commission
within the period as prescribed by said Act.
- (4) That the Commission has been duly organized and provided
and no objection has been made.
- (5) That the Commission of the proposed Basin-Excess Pool
are hereby and consistent with the Commission on practices.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc.,
and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the
Williams Well No. 1-14 located in Unit H of Section 24, Township
31 North, Range 13 West, T8N, R13W, S24, New Mexico, and
such a manner as to produce gas from the Basin-Excess Pool
and the Basin-Excess Pool through suitable means of drilling.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall comply, observe
and adhere to all the provisions of this Act.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall comply with
all the provisions of this Act and comply therewith during the
period of the Basin-Excess Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that jurisdiction of this case
is hereby assigned for the entry of such further orders as the
Commission may deem necessary.
