ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Greenbrier Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 28, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Sarah M. Hedges Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of July, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection II of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That waivers of objection have been received from all offset operators and that the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 112-A may be dispensed with at this time.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.


(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Greenbrier Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sarah M. Hedges Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section VI Rule 112-A.

Towmship 31 North, Range 15 West, San Juan County, New Mexico,
in which a number as to permit the production of gas from the Basin-
Mexican pool and the production pool to the Basin-Dodge pool.

Now, on this day of July, 1961, the Secretary
hereof finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the
provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and
Regulations.

(2) That association has been duly organized; and
that its objectives to file this application
from time to time to the Commission have been
described as follows: to consolidate the
gas wells 113-A may be taken away from the
Basin-Dodge pool.

(3) That the mechanism to file this application will not cause
any undue difficulties or delays.

(4) That the mechanism to file this application will be
concerned with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application filed by Greenfield Oil Company, per
the above mechanism, is hereby affirmed as the same is
set forth in the NE⁴ of Section 33, Township
31 North, Range 15 West, San Juan County, New Mexico,
in which a number as to permit the production of gas from the Basin-
Mexican pool and the production pool to the Basin-Dodge
pool, throughly bargaining and amicably to provide,

BROADBENT HOMMER, that application shall be granted.
Any changes made in accordance with the provisions of Section
113-A of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
