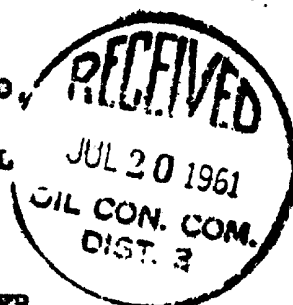


THE APPLICATION OF GREENBRIER OIL

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Greenbrier Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 28, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Sarah M. Hedges Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

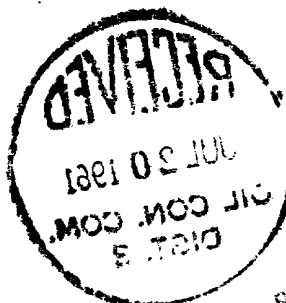
Now, on this 14th day of July, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection II of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from all offset operators and that the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 112-A may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Greenbrier Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sarah M. Hedges Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section VI Rule 112-A.
