2. Top of first stage cement at 2130' Cemented second stage thru Baker stage collar with 75 sxs. Reg. cement w/2% Gel. Top second stage cement at 1500'
3. Ran 84 jts. 2-3/4", 4.7#, J-55 tubing on May 28, 1959. Tubing landed at 2744 R.D.F.
