We Propose to Plug and Abandon well as follows:

1. Set Baker 5-1/2" Cast Iron Model "K" cement retainer at 2550 ft. Cement off Gallup perfs. from 2626 ft. to 2728 ft. w/70 sacks cement.
2. Fill 5-1/2" Casing w/9.0# drilling mud from top retainer at 2550 ft. to lowest free point in 5-1/2" casing. (Estimated 1400 feet)
3. Cut off 5-1/2" casing at lowest free point and pull from hole. Set cement plug in stub of 5-1/2" casing from 50 ft. inside casing to 100 ft. above top of Mancos formation using 90 sacks of cement. This plug will be across the bottom of the Point Lookout formation.
4. Fill hole from top of plug at 1250 ft. to 90 ft. using 9.0# drilling mud.
5. Set 50 sacks plug across bottom of surface casing from 50 ft. to 90 ft.
6. Set 10 sacks plug in top of surface casing.
7. Erect regulation dry hole marker and clean location. Abandon well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
