P On January 17, 1957 you applied for a non-standard proration unit consisting of the W/2 of Section 18, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool. This unit was to be dedicated to your Government Reid Well No. 1, located 1150 feet from the South line and 953 feet from the West line of said Section 18. 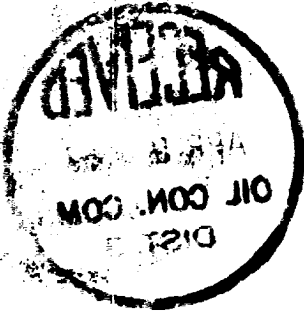
