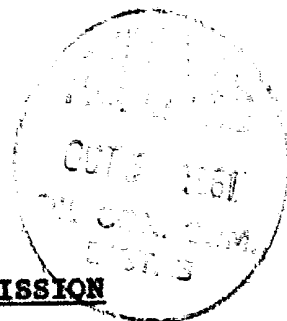


THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL & GAS, INC. FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS PRICE WELL NO. 1-15 LOCATED IN THE SE/4 SW/4 OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-MESAVERDE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 11, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Price Well No. 1-15 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 2nd day of October, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection II of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Price Well No. 1-15 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to duly complete its price Well No. 1-15 located in the SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Messaverde pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.
