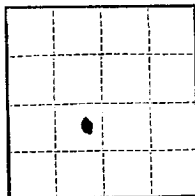

DETAILS OF WORK

The Ute Mt. Tribal ¹⁴ was drilled to a total depth of 3695 and then plugged back to 3550'. 5 1/2" casing was then set at 3035' with 275 sx neat cement in two stages. the stage collar was set at 1937'. After waiting on cement for 30 hrs, the casing was tested above and below the stage collar with 1000 psi for 30 min. Both tests showed the casing to be good. On Dec. 30 the well was fraced with 20,000 gal lease crude and 10,000 gal sand. Presently the well is shut in after frac. It will be placed on a production test after the normal waiting period.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
