Propose to: Set approximately 90' of 10 3/4" casing with 100 sacks cement. Drill to approximately 2465' - Set 5 1/2" casing at 2465' with 30 sacks cement. Set two-stage cement collar below siltstone marker at approximately 1661' and cement to base of Point Lookout formation with 30 sacks. Drill to total depth of 2545'.. Sand-oil free open hole with 40,000 gallons oil and 40,000 lbs. sand. Install 2 1/8" tubing, rods and pump.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations can be commenced.

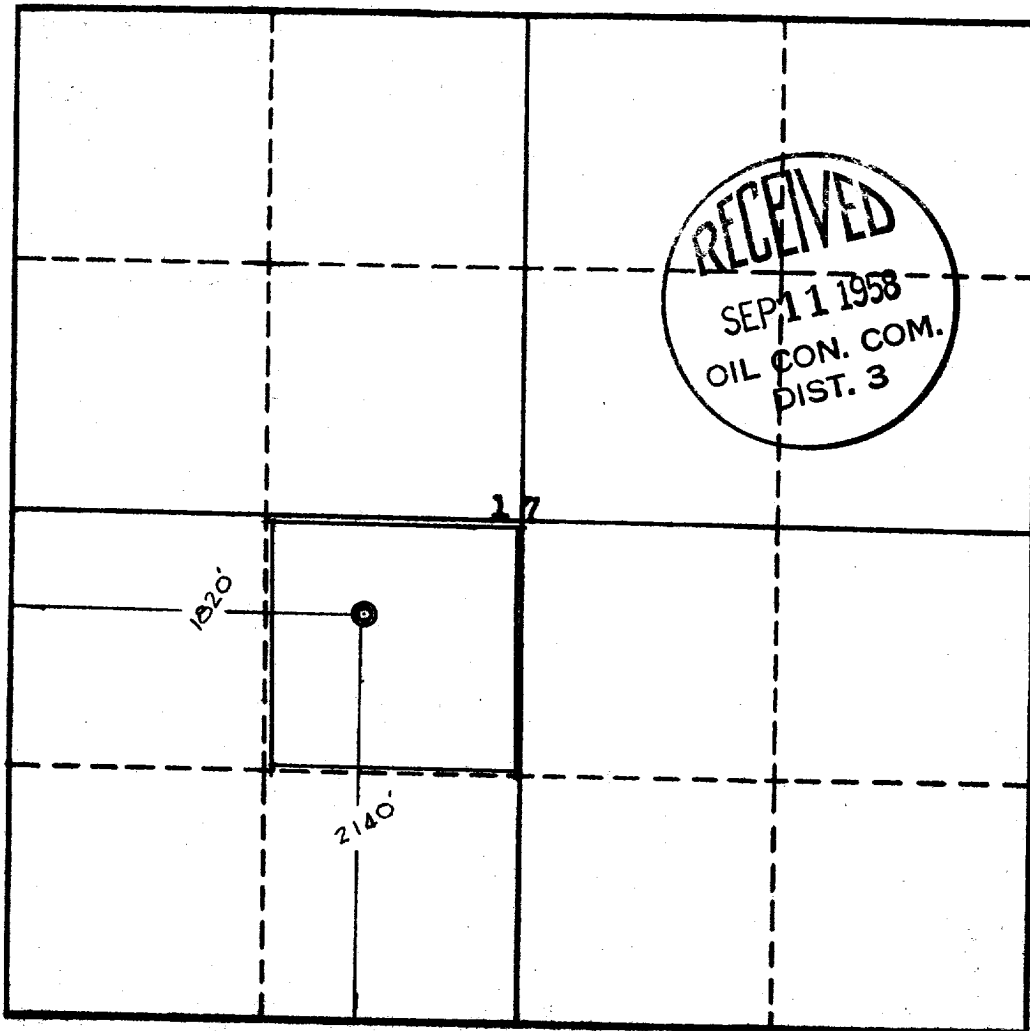
