

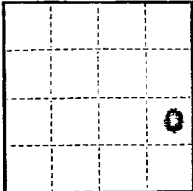

 Cement on 2nd stage through IV tool at 1093' with 60 sacks of cement.  
 Set on 3rd stage with 5000 pressure for 30 minutes. No losses.  
 Moved in Cable Tool. Drilled Cement plug 7/25/59.  
 Tested casing with 5000 pressure for 30 minutes. Pipe okay.
