1. Check location for anchors. Install if necessary. Test anchors.
2. MIRUSU. Blow down well. Kill if necessary with fresh water. NDWH. NUBOP.
3. POOH with 2" tbg. RIH with tbg and CIBP. Set CIBP at 4700'. Test csg integrity to 500#. Spot 100' cement plug on top. (33 cuft cement) Pull up hole and spot 100' cement plug across the Chacra at 3752' to 3652'. (33 cuft cement). RIH with perf gun and shoot squeeze holes at 2680' and attempt to circulate to surface. If unable to circulate besure to cover the following inside and outside the casing as follows:

Pictured cliffs at 2680 to 2580
Fruitland at 2256 to 2156
Ojo Alamo at 1000 to 900
and 225' to surface
(138 cuft inside csg and 158 cuft outside csg)
4. NDBOP. Cut off casing and wellhead. Install PXA marker according to BLM or State requirements.
5. Contact FMC and ship surface equipment to yard or other location per instructions.
6. Turn over to John Schwartz for reclamation.
7. Rehabilitate location according to BLM or State requirements.

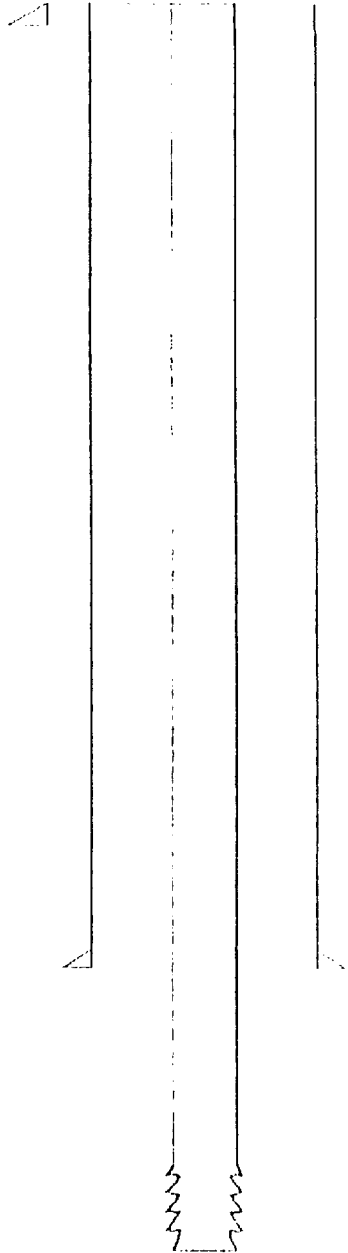


Reference is made to your well No. 12 Mudge B located 1681' ENL & 990' FEL Sec. 17, T. 31 N., R. 11 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, Lease NMSF-078096. The subject well was approved for long term shut in until April 1, 1996 to evaluate. To date, we have not received your plan for the above-mentioned well. If the well remains shut-in, you will be required to test the casing integrity. This office must be notified 48 hours prior to the test so it may be witnessed.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such requests, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the orders unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
