DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well thru the Dakota formation using rotary tools. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs and intermediate casing will be set. Gas circulation will be used thru the middle of the Greenhorn & 5 1/2" casing will be set. Mud circulation will be used thru the Dakota formation & production casing will be set. Est. T.D. 7755'.

Casing Program:

- 10 3/4" @ 2200' with 320 sacks cement circulated to surface.
- 7 5/8" @ 3100' with 390 sacks cement circulated to surface.
- 5 1/2" @ 7150' with 400 sacks cement - 200% to fill to 3100'.
- 4" @ 7755' with 100 sacks cement - 400% to fill to liner top.

The E/2 of Section 18 is dedicated to this well.

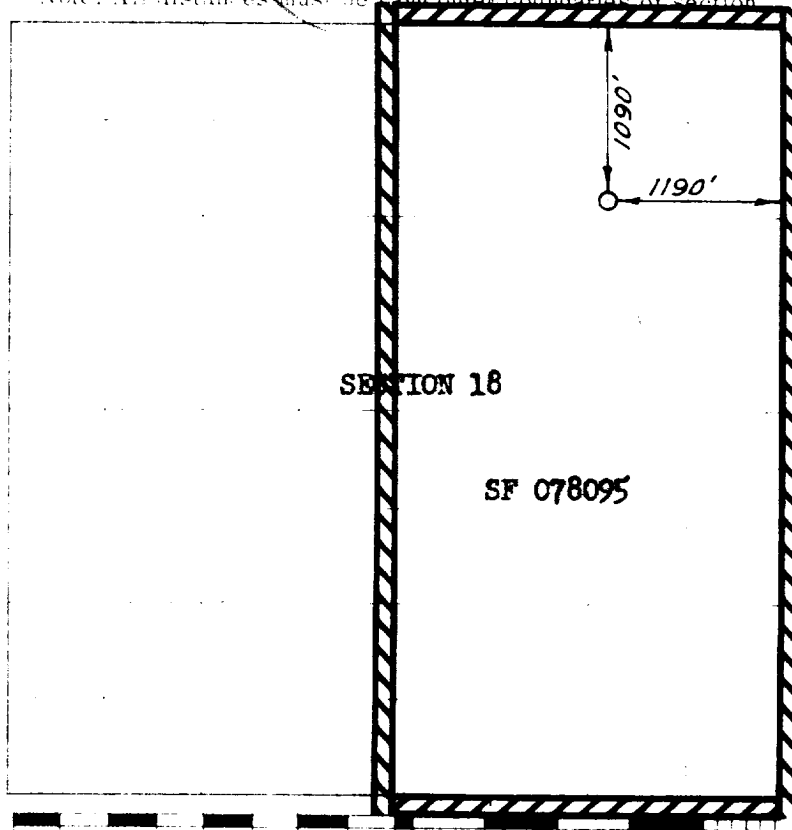
