


Astec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the East half ( $E\frac{1}{2}$ ), (or lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16), of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Astec-Davis No. 2 well, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 31 ~~North, Range 12~~ West, was completed March 6, 1950, as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on March 31, 1950.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 305.96 acres which are contiguous lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. Applicant is the only operator owning an interest in or offsetting the proposed unit.

Therefore, Astec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that under the provisions of Rule 1(b) of Order No. R-128-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant an exception to Rule 1(a), without notice and hearing,
