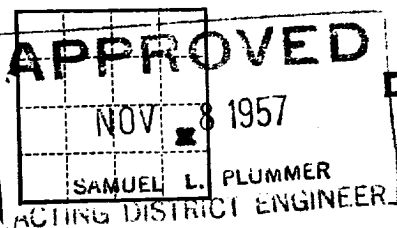

DETAILS OF WORK

10/30/57: Set 5-1/2" casing at 2624' w/150 sacks neat w/1/2# Fibers/cask. Lost returns while cementing. Stopped rotating and scratching and regained circulation. PCN 7:00 PM, 10/29/57. Temp. survey found top of cement at 1848'.

Released rotary and moved in completion rig.

11/3/57: Perf. 5-1/2" casing from 2448' - 2550' w/4 bullet shots/ft. Stabbed casing dry at 4:00 AM. NB oil or gas.

11/4/57: Sand-oil free w/35,322 gals. oil and 50,000# sand. Inj rate 40.8 bbls./min. at 900#, to 3200#. Used 270 rubber balls.
