DETAILS OF WORK

This well was completed as a Dakota gas well on May 24, 1961. It is our intention to perforate and free the Mesquite formation, and dual complete the well. Our program is as follows:  
Set Baker Model #1 production packer, type with push-out plug, at approximately 4990'. Perforate 4-1/2" OC casing at 4994-50' with 4 holes and run drill stem test to test cement job. If dry test is okay, it is our intention to perforate the 4-1/2" OC casing as follows with 4 shot per foot: 4435-4441', 4474-4480' and 4524-4530', and treat formation with 30,000' sand and 30,000 gallons water.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
