APPLICATION OF AMOCO PRODUCTION COMPANY

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Amoco Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 9, 1990, for permission to complete for salt water its Mudge "LS" Well No. 16, located in Unit B of Section 10, **Township 31 North, Range 11 West**, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The applicant herein, Amoco Production Company is hereby authorized to complete its Mudge "LS" Well No. 16 located in Unit B of Section 10, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Morrison formation at approximately 7428 feet to approximately 7570 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 7328 feet.
