DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of not obtaining commercial shows of oil or gas, we plugged and abandoned the Noted No. 1 on June 30, 1963 as follows:

1. Spaced 15 inches plug 6365-6360.
2. Cut 4-1/2" casing at 5350' and pulled sand. *SAME*
3. Spotted 70 inches cement plug 5107-5300.
4. Spotted 40 inches cement plug 4163-4300.
5. Pumped 100 inches cement in 8-5/8" and 13-3/8" annulus.
6. Spotted 20 inches cement plug 6-31' in 8-5/8" casing.
7. Cut off well head. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
