DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 1" hole 5/20/59, set 7-1/2" casing at 40' w/7 casing reg. cement. Drilled surface hole w/air & mudded up. Drilled 6-1/2" hole to 20' of 1800'. RIG 1800'. Run casing, 2400'. Set 3" casing at 1800' w/70 casing 24 casing cement. Pumped plug down w/200 gals. Mm and oil. Run casing 24' & cement 1400'. Perforated from 900' to 1000' w/3 jet shots per shot. Cement/kill from w/12,000 gals. Run, circulate, 12,000/ and 120 gals. 1-70. Stop. Inj. rate 20 bbls./min. at 900'. Chased 60' of sand from casing. Set 2" tubing at 900'. Run rods & pump out old pumping unit. On final 24 hour test on 14-50" SWP pumped 70 bbls. now RIG. Qm. 20. First new oil to tank 6/12/59.
