 pack cement. Tamped plug down w/300 gals. oil & oil. Run Gamma Ray & collar logs.
 Perforated from 1074' to 1074 1/2' w/20,000 gals. sand/oil time w/20,000 gals.
 100' grade, 30,000 sand & 110 gals. 1-40. Ann. test rate 17 bbls./min. @ 900'.
 Cleaned sand from 1071' to 1065'. Set 2" casing at 1057'. Run pump & rods and
