Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent letter to Mr. Daniel S. Nutter of this office regarding the above-captioned well, wherein you stated that although staked and spudded as a conventional location in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 13 East, NMPM, the deviation from the vertical was of such magnitude as to cause the well to be bottomed in the Gallup formation in the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 5. It is our understanding that the ownership of both quarter-quarter sections is identical.

Inasmuch as the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5 is the only 40-acre tract which has been proven productive by the subject well, and is in fact the tract which is being drained by same, it is the opinion of the Commission that this is the tract which should be dedicated to the well.

We are, therefore, by carbon copy of this letter, requesting the Aztec office of the Commission to make whatever amendments may be necessary to the well-file and the proration schedule to properly reflect that the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5 is dedicated to the well.
