

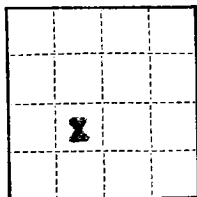

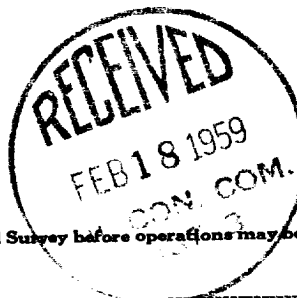

Drilled 6-1/4" hole to a total depth of 1153'. Ran 36 lbs. of 4" OD Casing, set at 1131'. Cemented with 70 wt. 15 Gal. Chl. Cement. Plug on bottom 11:30 PM 2-11-59. Rotated pipe and complete circulation while cementing. Released rig at 12:00 midnight 2-11-59. WCC.
