Dear Mr. Hewitt:

On July 11, 1953 we received a Notice of Intention to Drill for Well #1 Israel in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6-31N-10W, which was to be drilled to the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

On August 17, 1953 we received a Notice of Intention to Drill from Stanolind Oil & Gas Co. for the Sammons Gas Unit #1 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6-31N-10W, which is also to be completed in the Blanco Mesaverde Pool. I called Mr. Hinkle, Field Engineer for Stanolind Oil & Gas Co. in Farmington, New Mexico and he advised me that Stanolind and Beaver Lodge had made a unit agreement on this acreage and that Stanolind is to drill this well and be the operator.

In order that our files may be complete and correct it will be necessary for you to submit a Form C-102 notifying us of the change in plans concerning this location. Will you please submit 5 copies of the Form C-102 so that we may forward the necessary copies to the U.S.G.S.
