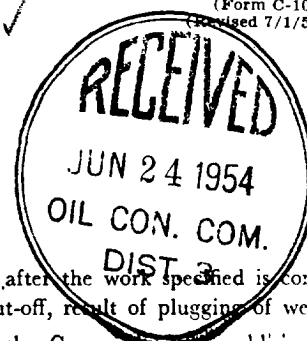

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

The well was drilled to a total depth of 5075 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 4472 to 4925 feet open with 1382 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with gas and 2" tubing was landed at 5024 feet. Well was shut-in 9 days. Shut-in casing pressure 1066 psi. Three hour potential test 4169 MCFPD, June 7, 1954.
