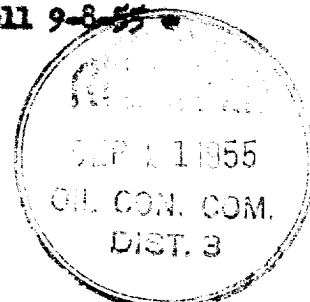

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-18-55 - Moved in cable tools and rigged up same. 8-21-55 - Pulled 165 fts of 2" tubing - Cleaned out to 5080 ft. 8-31-55 - Set 145' of 2" tubing, landed at 4856. 9-1-55 - Sand frac from 4837 to 5080 with 11,000 gals. diesel oil, 9,000 gals. flush, 16,000 lbs. sand. Breakdown pressure 1000#, Treating Pressure 750#, Final pressure Zero lbs. I.R. 43.5 barrels/minute. Estimated 1500 to 2000 mcf/day after frac. Shut-in for gauge. Gauged well 9-8-55. Initial Potential 2463 mcf/day, SICP 878, SITP 871.
