ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2541, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on March 6, 1964, for permission to expand its Many Rocks-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th day of May, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2541.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2541.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of Pressure Maintenance, to wit:

Humble Navajo Tribe Well No. G-15 located in the
NW/4 NE/4 of Section 2, and
Humble Navajo Tribe Well No. G-17 located in the
SE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, both
in Township 31 North, Range ~~16~~ West, NMPM.
