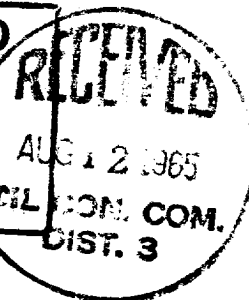

skin zone, and thus increase injectivity. Spearhead with 1225 gallons untreated
water, follow with 2100 gallons frac fluid (700 gals. w/3/4#/gal. 20-40 sand;
1000 gals. w/1/4#/gal. 20-40 sand, and 400 gals. w/1/2#/gal. 12-20 glass beads).
Return well to injection.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
