Conditions of Approval

To temporarily abandon a well, you are required to install a bridge plug or a cement plug no more than 50 feet above each set of open perforations and the well bore filled with conditioned, non-corrosive fluid and shut-in at the surface. If a bridge plug is used, it must be capped with 50 foot of cement.

You are also required to test the casing integrity. Bill Blackard is to be contacted 48hrs before the test so it may be witnessed. He can be reached at (505) 327-5344. If the casing test is not completed by July 15, 1988 the subject approval will expire on that date. If the casing test fails, you will be required to submit your plans to repair the casing or plug and abandon the subject well.
