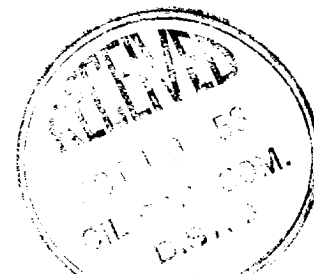

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to a total depth of 5290 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 4677 to 5290 feet open with 1478 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with gas and 2" tubing landed at 5255 feet. Well shut in 7 days. Shut in casing pressure 107 1/2 psi. Three hour potential test 4260 MCPL, August 23, 1953.

Well shut in for pipe line connection.
