

Water fractured Upper Point Lookout from 5692' to 5776' (through perforations, 4 holes per foot) with 24,260 gallons water and 18,000# sand. Breakdown pressure 0#, maximum treating pressure 2500#, average treating pressure 1500#. Injection rate 3 1/2 bbls./min. Flush 820 gallons. Natural gas, no gas.
