On 4-19-66, cut stuck tubing off with chemical cutter at 4935', left 515' of 2 3/8" tubing in open hole. Set cement retainer at 4715', tested 7" casing to 1200%, O.K.
On 4-20-66, squeezed open hole w/200 sks regular cement, 1/2 cu. ft. Strata-Crete 5"/sk., 6% gel and 100 sks. regular cement, w/15% sand and 2% calcium chloride. Perforated 2 squeeze holes at 2600', set packer at 2448', squeezed through perfs at 2600' w/100 sacks regular cement, 2% calcium chloride. Drilled out cement, pumped in at 500%. Re-squeezed through perfs at 2600' w/100 sacks regular cement, 2% calcium chloride. Staged to 1500%.
On 4-21-66 drilled out cement, and tested squeeze holes at 2600' w/500%, Held O.K.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
