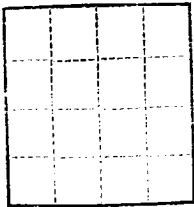

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde and production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated and fractured. Estimated Total Depth 6243'.

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 150 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 3053' with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" liner at 6253' with 300 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 28 is dedicated to this well.

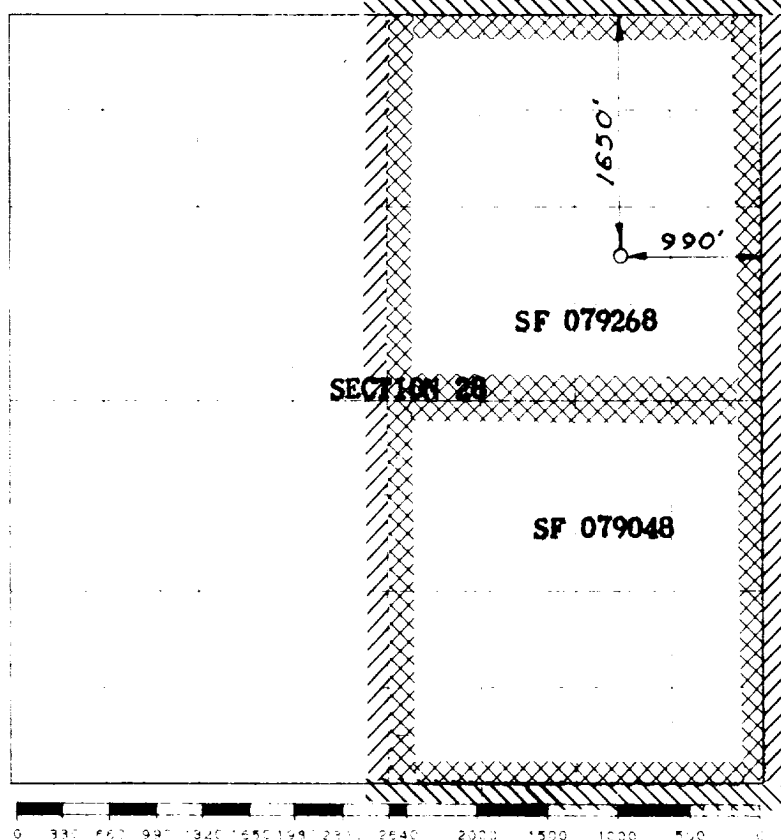
