THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS ALLISON UNIT WELL NO. 17, LOCATED 1650 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 1650 FEET FROM THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE DAKOTA FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE NORTH OIL CON. ## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the previsions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 10, 1958, for permission to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 17, located 1650 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 24, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Dakota formation adjacent to the North Los Pinos Dakota Poel and the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

Now on this 18th day of November, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly netified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the muchanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Pase Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorised to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 17 located 1650 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 24, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Dakota formation adjacent to the North Los Pines Dakota Peel and the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Poel, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and amountly thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the North Los Pines Dakota Pool.
