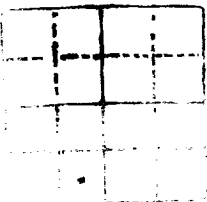

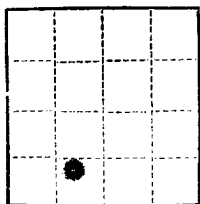

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposes: To set 9 5/8" casing at 150 with 150 sacks cement. Drill plug with battery and run to approximately 550, top of Point Lookout, and set 7" casing with 150 sacks. Drill cement plug with gun and drill to a total depth of approximately 550. Open hole will be mud-filled with approximately 20,000 gals. diesel and 20,000 lbs. mud, cleaned out to T.B. and 7" tubing installed at approximately 550 ft.

Protraction Unit - $\frac{1}{4}$ - Section 19 - 112.40 acres.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
