DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 4:00 P.M., June 4, 1954. On June 5, 1954, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 248 feet and cemented with 190 sacks cement. Cement plug down at 7:40 P.M., June 5, 1954. At 7:00 A.M., June 7, 1954 casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Forty-one feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
