It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Dakota formation and Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the pictured Cliffs & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the middle of the Greenhorn formation & 7" liner will be set. Mud circulation will be used thru the Dakota formation & production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Est. T. D. 6675'.

Casing Program:

- 13 3/8" at 300' w/600 sks. cement circulated to surface.
- 9 5/8" at 3050' w/900 sks. cement in two stages.
- 7" at 6379' w/600 sks cement.
- 5" at 6675 w/100 sks. cement.

The 2/2 of section 21 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde formation.

The 1/2 of Section 21 is dedicated to the Dakota formation

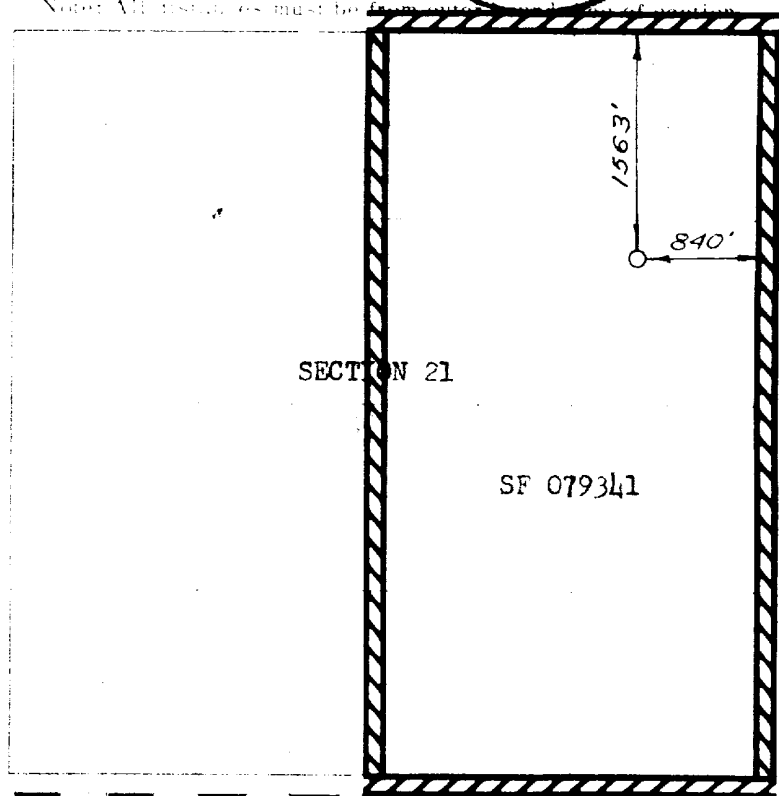
