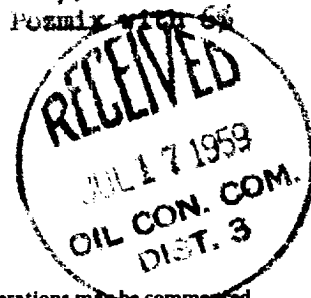
DETAILS OF WORK

On 7-7-59 Total Depth 3959'.
Ran 132 joints 9 5/8", 36.00#, J-55 casing (3947') set at 3957'. Two stage cementing tool at 3058'. First stage 110 sacks regular cement, 110 sacks Pozmix with 4% Gel and 1/4 cu. ft. Strata-Crete "6"/sk, followed w/50 sacks Neat cement. Second stage 435 sacks regular cement, 435 sacks Pozmix with 6% Gel and 2% Calcium Chloride followed by 50 sacks Neat cement.

Top of cement by temperature survey on second stage at 1820'.
