

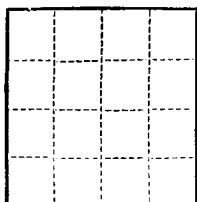

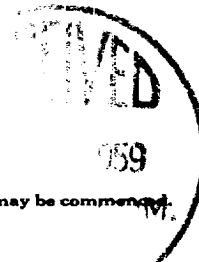

DETAILS OF WORK

July 18, 1959 Total depth 3957'.
Set cement plug (50 sacks 50/50 Pozmix, 6% Gel, 2% Calcium Chloride at 2828-3013'.
Cut off 9 5/8", 36.00#, J-55 casing at 319', and retrieved 27 joints.
Set plugs (each one consisting of 50 sacks 50/50 Pozmix, 6% Gel, 2% Calcium Chloride at 750' - 848', and from surface to 60'.
A permanent marker (4" pipe 4' long) will be installed when the drilling rig leaves location.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
