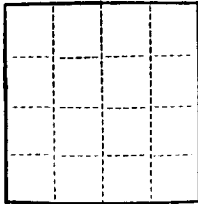

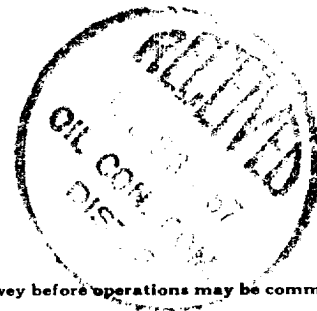

Top of cement by temperature survey at 3510'.
