ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 13, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 20, located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 18, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the North Los Pinos-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of August, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Allison Unit Well No. 20, located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 18, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the North Los Pinos-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

THE APPLICATION OF THE EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO DRILL A DUAL COMPLETION OF THE ALLISON UNIT WELL NO. 20, LOCATED IN SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, MEXICO, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE EL PASO RESERVOIR POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE NORTH LOS PINOS RESERVOIR POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 12, (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 13, 1939, for permission to drill and complete its Allison Unit Well No. 20, located in the NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, MEXICO, NEW MEXICO, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the El Paso Reservoir Pool and the production of gas from the North Los Pinos Reservoir Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of August, 1939, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application was made by the El Paso Natural Gas Company in accordance with the provisions of Rule 12, (c) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil wells in the area have been duly notified, and

3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor injury to correlative rights.

5. That the necessities of the proposed dual completion are deemed to be consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill and complete its Allison Unit Well No. 20, located in the NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, MEXICO, NEW MEXICO, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the El Paso Reservoir Pool and the production of gas from the North Los Pinos Reservoir Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

REVIEWED, HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 12-A.

RECOMMENDED, FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test period for the El Paso Reservoir Pool.
