DETAILS OF WORK

State names of and expected depth of objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging instruments; log points; and all other important proposed work.

This well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner:

100 sacks of cement was displaced with 83 barrels of water, followed by 100 sacks of cement and 130 barrels of water. Pressure to 1500#, 20 sacks of cement were placed in the top of the surface casing and a 4" x 4' plug and abandonment marker installed 6-13-63.
