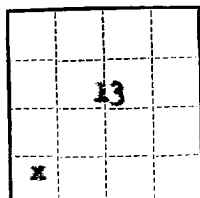

IR 2nd half treatment 22 bbls/min. Balled off in mid-treatment - shut down 30" before resuming treatment. Dropped 110 Western Balls.

Cleaned out to Total Depth, set 6206.19' of 2-3/8 tubing @ 6216.19', completed well.
