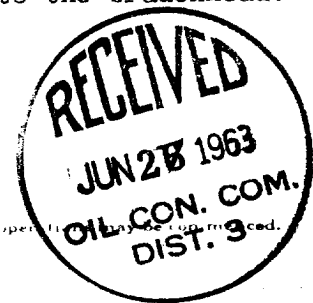

DETAILS OF WORK

State names of cities, colored depth, total number of miles, water rights, and type of proposed easings indicate mudding jobs, cementing jobs, and a third component of proposed work.

This well was temporarily abandoned on May 17, 1963, in the following manner:

100 sack cement plug was spotted down tubing with bottom of tubing @ 6154'. Pulled 41 joints of tubing, W.O.C. 18 hours. Attempt to pull rest of tubing, found tubing stuck @ 4606'. Cut off tubing with McCullough chemical cutter @ 4585'. Bolted well head assembly with well sign back onto the bradenhead.
