DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8660' - Total Depth - Sand. Cement plugs as follows: 25 sacks cement from 8660' to 8568' and 30 sacks cement from 8660' to 7990' with heavy mud between the plugs and from 7990' to the surface. A compension flange was installed on the top of the 16" surface casing, which was gauged to 2" and a 2" gate valve was installed. Well temporarily abandoned at 5:00 A.M., 10-26-50.

There remains in the well 16" O.D., 454, L.N. casing, set at 465' and 10-3/4" O.D., 40.54, Grade J-55, Range 1 & 3, S-M. Std. S.E. casing, set at 3545'.
