
This letter is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company is in the process of dually completing the following well:

Allison Unit No. 12 (MD)

NE 14-32-7

This well will be dually completed in the Mesa Verde-Dakota as a gas-gas dual. A packer will be installed on the 2-3/8" tubing between the zones with a sidedoor choke installed in the 2-3/8" tubing above the production packer. Upon final successful completion a formal application for administrative approval will be made to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe.
