It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

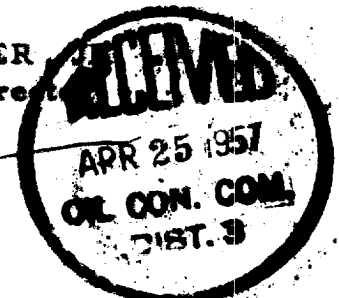

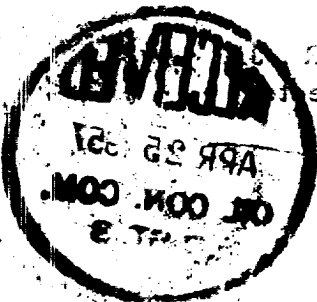
